ESDD helps lenders' clients improve their business performance, enhance transparency, engage with the people affected by the projects, protect the environment, and achieve greater development impact.

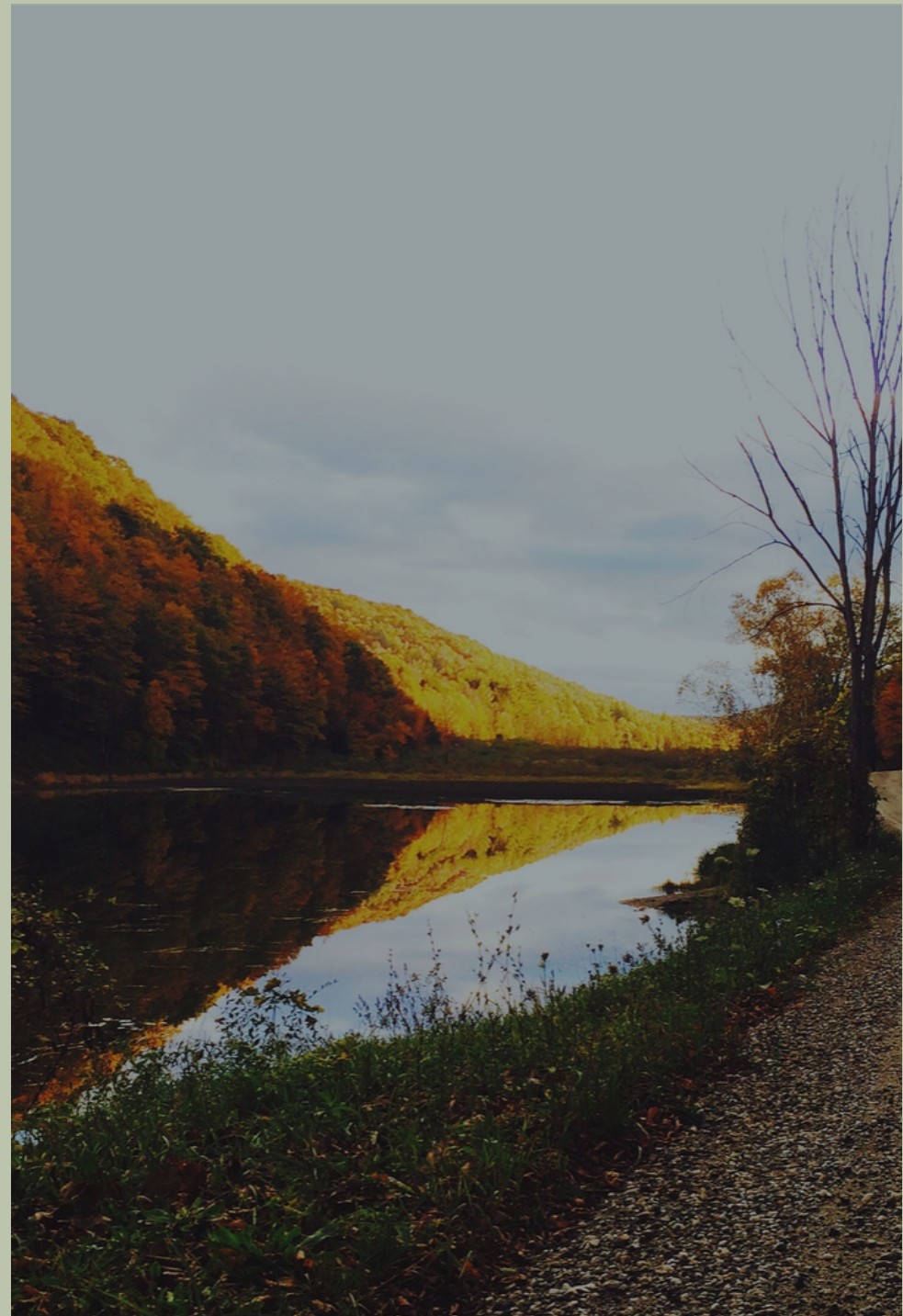
ESDD forms part of a lender's Sustainability Framework that articulates strategic commitment to sustainable development, and is an integral part of the lenders' approach to risk management.
